

TREMFYA® (guselkumab)

What are the possible side effects of TREMFYA?

TREMFYA may cause serious side effects, including:

Serious allergic reactions¹



Stop using TREMFYA and get emergency medical help right away if you develop any of the following symptoms of a serious allergic reaction:

- Fainting, dizziness, or feeling lightheaded (low blood pressure)
- Swelling of your face, eyelids, lips, mouth, tongue, or throat
- Trouble breathing or throat tightness
- Chest tightness
- Skin rash or hives
- Itching

Infections¹



TREMFYA is a medicine that may lower the ability of your immune system to fight infections and may increase your risk of infections.

Your healthcare provider should check you for infections and tuberculosis (TB) before starting treatment with TREMFYA. If you have a history of TB or have active TB, they may treat you for TB before you begin treatment with TREMFYA.

Your healthcare provider should watch you closely for signs and symptoms of TB during and after treatment with TREMFYA.

Tell your healthcare provider right away if you have an infection or have symptoms of an infection, including the following:

- Fever, sweats, or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Blood in your phlegm (mucus)
- Muscle aches
- Warm, red, or painful skin or sores on your body different from your psoriasis
- Weight loss
- Diarrhea or stomach pain
- Burning when you urinate or urinating more often than normal

Liver problems¹



With the treatment of Crohn's disease or ulcerative colitis, your healthcare provider will do blood tests to check your liver before and during treatment with TREMFYA.

Your healthcare provider may stop treatment with TREMFYA if you develop liver problems.

Tell your healthcare provider right away if you notice any of the following symptoms:

- Unexplained rash
- Vomiting
- Tiredness (fatigue)
- Yellowing of the skin or the whites of your eyes
- Nausea
- Stomach pain (abdominal)
- Loss of appetite
- Dark urine

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What are the possible side effects of TREMFYA?

The most common side effects of TREMFYA include¹:



Respiratory tract infections



Diarrhea



Joint pain (arthralgia)



Herpes simplex infections



Fungal skin infections



Injection site reactions



Bronchitis



Stomach flu (gastroenteritis)



Headache



Stomach pain
