What is the dosing schedule of TREMFYA for plaque psoriasis?

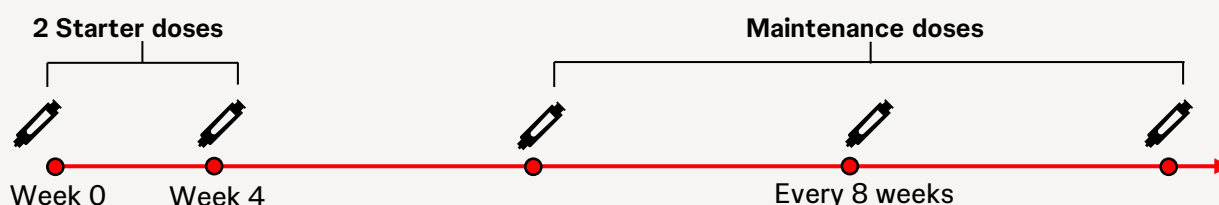
Dosage form and strengths¹

Subcutaneous injection:



- 100 mg/mL in a single-dose One-Press patient-controlled injector
- 100 mg/mL in a single-dose prefilled syringe
- 100 mg/mL in a single-dose prefilled pen (TREMFYA PEN)

Recommended dosage schedule for **adults** with plaque psoriasis¹



Tremfya is administered as a single **100 mg** injection under the skin at **weeks 0 and 4**, and then every **8 weeks**.

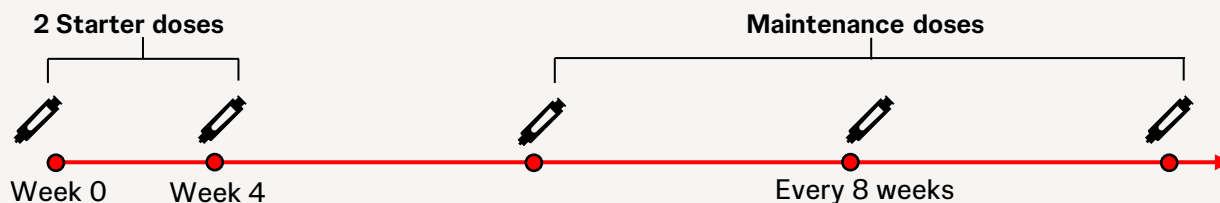


If your healthcare provider decides that you or a caregiver may be able to give your injections of TREMFYA at home, **you should receive training** on the right way to prepare and inject TREMFYA before attempting to inject.



Do not try to inject yourself until you have been shown the right way to give the injections by your healthcare provider.

Recommended dosage schedule for **children 6 years of age and older who also weigh at least 88 pounds (40 kg)** with plaque psoriasis¹



Tremfya is administered as a single **100 mg** injection under the skin at **weeks 0 and 4**, and then **every 8 weeks**.



TREMFYA should be administered by a **healthcare provider** or an **adult caregiver** who has been shown the right way to give the injections by your healthcare provider.
